

Plastic Soap Dish

What You Need:

- 1 or two liter plastic bottle, empty clean and dry
- Hole punch
- Scissors
- Paint markers
- Craft knife



What You Do;

1. Help your child start the project by cutting a slit with a craft knife into the bottle at the half-way point. The slit should be large enough that your child can slide a hole punch into the bottle.
2. Have them slide the hole punch into the bottle and punch out a hole. Then draw a straight line around the bottle matching up to either side of the punched out hole.
3. Use the scissors to cut along the line. The hole punch should be enough area to begin cutting from.
4. Recycle the top portion of the bottle, or set it aside for another project.
5. Draw a wavy line around the top edge of the cut bottle to create a scalloped edge. Cut around the wavy line and recycle the leftover plastic.
6. Use the paint markers to design a fun and beautiful pattern around the base of the plastic bottle, turning it into a soap dish.
7. Place your favorite smelling soap in your new dish while you help save the environment.
